
OAKVILLE MARKET AT A GLANCE

Strong Spring Market as Interest Rates Hold

After one of the fastest rate tightening cycles in the Bank of Canada's history, many buyers moved to the sidelines in 2022.

On April 12th. the Bank of Canada held its key interest rate at 4.5% for the second consecutive month. In Oakville, we returned to a seller's market as buyers re-entered the market and competed in a tight supply market. Exceptional, move-in ready homes generated multiple offers, and in some cases, achieved sale prices over asking.

In April, the average sale price of a detached home was \$2,008,913, which is 6.9% lower than the same time last year. In the townhouse/semi-detached category, the average sale price was \$1,177,761, which is a 3.61% increase Year-Over-Year.
